WILLOW YARN BOX CARDIGAN

No. 3804—Size 14

- 1 Pr. Standard No. 13 Needles—14 in.
1 Size 9 Bone Crochet Hook

SCALE: 3 sts to 1 in.

Jack Frost Willow Yarn—14 2-oz. Skeins

BACK: Cast on 52 sts. Work in pattern as given for Fitted Cardigan No. 3803, until piece measures 15½ in. from lower edge. Bind off 4 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows for underarm; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 4 times. Work even until piece measures 7 in. from underarm. Bind off 4 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows, then 3 sts at beginning of each of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining sts for back of neck.

RIGHT FRONT: Cast on 28 sts. Work even in pattern until piece measures 15½ in. from lower edge. Keeping front edge even, bind off 4 sts at underarm edge once, then decrease 1 st at underarm edge every other row 4 times. Work even until piece measures 5½ in. from underarm. Keeping armhole edge even, bind off 6 sts at neck edge once, then decrease 1 st at neck edge every row 4 times. Work even until piece measures 7 in. from underarm. Starting at shoulder edge, bind off 4 sts once then 3 sts every other row 2 times. Work other side to correspond. Sew shoulder and underarm seams.

SLEEVES: Cast on 24 sts. Work in pattern for 8 rows. Increase 1 st at each end of the 9th row and every 8th row thereafter to 40 sts. Work even until piece measures 18½ in. from lower edge. Bind off 5 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 4 times. Work even until piece measures 5 in. from bound off sts at underarm. Bind off 7 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows. Work even on remaining 8 sts for 7 rows. Bind off. Sew sleeve seams. Sew bound off sts at top of sleeve to edges of insert. Sew sleeves in place.

PATCH POCKETS: Cast on 16 sts. Work even in pattern for 22 rows. Bind off. Work 1 row of s c around entire pocket and sew to fronts of cardigan as illustrated. Work 1 row of s c around entire opening.

FINGERING YARN TWIN SET

CARDIGAN No. 3805—Size 14

- 1 Pr. Standard No. 2 Needles—14 in.
1 Pr. Standard No. 4 Needles—14 in.
1 Double Pointed Needle

SCALE: 7 sts to 1 in.

Gold Medal Fingering Yarn (A Jack Frost Product) 8 1-oz. Skeins

BACK: With No. 2 Needles cast on 116 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 2 in. Change to No. 4 Needles and work even in stockinette st until piece measures 15 in. from lower edge. Bind off 5 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 5 times. Work even until piece measures 6½ in. from underarm. Bind off 7 sts at beginning of each of next 8 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

RIGHT FRONT: With No. 2 Needles cast on 65 sts. Keeping first 7 sts worked in garter st for buttonhole band, work in ribbing of P 1, K 1, over remaining sts for 1 in., then work first buttonhole as follows: K 2, bind off next 3 sts, work across row. On next row, cast on 3 sts over the 3 bound off sts. Repeat buttonholes every 2½ in. to neck edge. When ribbing measures 2 in. from lower edge, change to No. 4 Needles and work in pattern as follows: **Row 1 (Wrong side)**—P 32, K 2, P 2, K 1, P 2, K 1, P 2, K 2, P 14, K 7. **Row 2**—K 21, P 2, K 2, P 1, K 2, P 1, K 2, P 2, K 32. **Row 3**—Repeat Row 1. **Row 4**—K 21, P 2, slip next 3 sts to double pointed needle (D.P.N.), hold in back of work. K next 2 sts, slip the P st from D.P.N. to left hand needle, and P it, then K the 2 sts from D.P.N., P 1, K 2, P 2, K 32. **Row 5**—Repeat Row 1. **Row 6**—Repeat Row 2. **Row 7**—Repeat Row 1. **Row 8**—K 21, P 2, K 2, P 1, slip next 3 sts to D.P.N. hold in front of work, K next 2 sts, slip the P st from D.P.N. to left hand needle and P it, then K the 2 sts from D.P.N. P 2, K 32. Repeat above 8 rows until piece measures 15 in. from lower edge. Continuing cable band, bind off 5 sts at underarm edge once; decrease 1 st at armhole edge every other row 5 times. Work even until piece measures 4¾ in. from underarm. Starting at front edge, work over 7 sts. Place on pin. Bind off next 10 sts. Keeping armhole edge even, decrease 1 st at neck edge every

row 10 times. Work even until armhole measures 6½ in. from underarm. Starting at shoulder edge bind off 7 sts every other row 4 times. Work other side to correspond, reversing instructions and omitting buttonholes.

Sew shoulder and underarm seams.

SLEEVES: With No. 2 Needles cast on 48 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 3 in. Change to No. 4 Needles increasing to 62 sts at even intervals across row. Work even in stockinette st for 2 in., thereafter to 86 sts. Work even until piece measures 18½ in. from lower edge.

Bind off 8 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 5 times, then every 3rd row 6 times. Bind off 2 sts at beginning of each of next 16 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

Sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place.

NECKBAND: With No. 2 Needles, on right side of garment, pick up 111 sts from end to end of neckband, including sts which were placed on pin. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 8 rows working last buttonhole on 2nd row. Bind off.

MATCHING PULLOVER

No. 3806—Size 14

- 1 Pr. Standard No. 2 Needles—14 in.
1 Pr. Standard No. 4 Needles—14 in.
1 Double Pointed Needle

SCALE: 7 sts to 1 in.

Gold Medal Fingering Yarn (A Jack Frost Product) 6 1-oz. Skeins

BACK: With No. 2 Needles cast on 110 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 3 in. Change to No. 4 Needles and work even in stockinette st until piece measures 11½ in. from lower edge. Bind off 5 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows for underarm; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 4 times. Work even until piece measures 6½ in. from underarm. Bind off 7 sts at beginning of each of next 8 rows. Change to No. 2 Needles, increasing to 43 sts at even intervals across row. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 8 rows for neckband. Bind off.

FRONT: With No. 2 Needles cast on 110 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 3 in. Change to No. 4 Needles, increasing to 132 sts at even intervals across row. Work in pattern as follows: **Row 1 (Wrong side)**—P 23, * K 2, P 2, K 1, P 2, K 1, P 2, K 2, P 25, repeat from * once, ending K 2, P 2, K 1, P 2, K 1, P 2, K 2, P 23. **Row 2**—K 23, * P 2, K 2, P 1, K 2, P 1, K 2, P 2, K 25, repeat from * once, ending P 2, K 2, P 1, K 2, P 1, K 2, P 2, K 23. **Row 3**—Repeat Row 1. **Row 4**—K 23, * P 2, slip next 3 sts to D.P.N., hold in back of work. K next 2 sts, slip the P st from D.P.N. to left hand needle, and P it, then K the 2 sts from D.P.N., P 1, K 2, P 2, K 25, repeat from * once, cable as before over next 12 sts, K 23. **Row 5**—Repeat Row 1. **Row 6**—Repeat Row 2. **Row 7**—Repeat Row 1. **Row 8**—K 23, * P 2, K 2, P 1, slip next 3 sts to D.P.N., hold in front of work, K next 2 sts, slip the P st from D.P.N. to left hand needle, and P it, then K the 2 sts from D.P.N., P 2, K 25, repeat from * once, cable over next 12 sts as before, K 23. Repeat above 8 rows until piece measures 11½ in. from lower edge. Bind off 8 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows for underarm; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 6 times. Work even until piece measures 4½ in. from underarm. Work over first 38 sts, place on st-holder, bind off next 28 sts for front of neck. On remaining 38 sts work 2 rows even. Keeping armhole edge even, bind off 2 sts at neck edge every other row 4 times. Work even until piece measures 6½ in. from underarm. Starting at shoulder edge, bind off 8 sts every other row 2 times, then 7 sts every other row 2 times. Work other side to correspond.

FRONT NECK BAND: With No. 2 Needles, on right side of garment, pick up 89 sts from shoulder to shoulder. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 8 rows. Bind off. Sew shoulder and underarm seams.

SLEEVES: With No. 2 Needles cast on 75 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for 1½ in. Change to No. 4 Needles, work in stockinette st, increasing 1 st at each end every 4th row to 87 sts. Work even until piece measures 4½ in. from lower edge. Bind off 8 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 6 times, then every 4th row 6 times. Bind off 2 sts at beginning of each of next 14 rows. Bind off remaining sts. Sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place.
