FINGERING YARN STRIPED PULLOVER

No. 3807—Size 14

1 Pr. Standard No. 1 Needles—14 in.

1 Pr. Standard No. 3 Needles—14 in.

SCALE: $7\frac{1}{2}$ sts to 1 in.

Gold Medal Fingering Yarn (A Jack Frost Product)

4 1-oz. Skeins Navy—2 1-oz. Skeins Red

BACK: With No. 1 Needles, and Navy (N), cast on 119 sts. Work in ribbing of K 1, P 1, for $3\frac{1}{2}$ in. Change to No. 3 Needles and work even in stockinette st as follows: * 2 rows Red (R), 6 rows N, 2 rows R, 4 rows N, repeat from * to neck edge. When piece measures 12 in. from lower edge, and 13th red stripe has been completed, bind off 6 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows for underarm; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 6 times. Work even until piece measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ in. from underarm. Bind off 7 sts at beginning of each of next 8 rows. Change to No. 1 Needles, K 1 row, P 1 row for 5 rows, K 1 row on wrong side for turning ridge, K 1 row, P 1 row for 5 rows, for neckband. Bind off.

FRONT: Work same as back until piece measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ in. from underarm. Work over 33 sts, bind off next 29 sts. On remaining 33 sts decrease 1 st at neck edge every other row 5 times. Work even until piece measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ in. from underarm. Starting at shoulder edge, bind off 7 sts every other row 4 times. Work other side to correspond.

FRONT NECK BAND: With No. 1 Needles, and N, on right side of garment, pick up 78 sts from shoulder to shoulder. P 1 row, K 1 row for 5 rows. P 1 row on right side for turning ridge. P 1 row, K 1 row for 5 rows. Bind off.

Sew shoulder and underarm seams. Turn neckband under on turning ridge and sew to wrong side.

SLEEVES: With No. 1 Needles, and N, cast on 90 sts. K 1 row, P 1 row for 8 rows. P 1 row on right side for turning ridge. P 1 row, K 1 row for $1\frac{3}{4}$ in. from turning ridge. Then work as follows: * 2 rows R, 4 rows N, 2 rows R, 6 rows N, repeat from * for entire sleeve. When 4 red stripes have been completed, bind off 6 sts at beginning of each of next 2 rows; decrease 1 st at each end every other row 6 times, then every 4th row 6 times. Bind off 2 sts at beginning of each of next 16 rows. Bind off remaining sts. Sew sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place, matching stripes. Turn hems under on lower edge of sleeve, and sew to wrong side.
